The FRIENDS celebrated their 15th year by featuring Hermosa Beach authors.

Gifts to the Library included: two bean bag chairs and ten display boards for the children's area, a new aquarium, a Christmas tree, subscriptions to The New Yorker, Arizona Highways and The Easy Reader, a daylight movie screen donated by Pat and Myron Gazin, two books on Mexico donated by Lorraine and John Hales and an autographed copy of The Graphic Work of Louis Monza.
