Two new bean bag chairs (so popular with the youngsters that they wore out two !) were also authorized.

COACHING VERY YOUNG SOCCER PLAYERS, a frequently requested title, is already on order for TWO copies.

Great news: The Woman's Club of Hermosa Beach has authorized \$100\$ donation for record gifts to the library.

Frequent requests voiced at the library by patrons are for travel books, titles from the Historic Cities series and for Beatrix Potter titles in foreign languages. Librarian, Shari Petresky reports that Fodors, Fielding, Waldos, of any vintage, are highly desireable.

This includes funds for system referral grants, universal borrowing and interlibrary loans.
