BARDGATE: OUR LATEST CHALLENGE

The formidable permanent security gate that now guards the entrance to Bard Street from Pier Avenue has become slightly more daunting because of the Fire Department's \$1.8 million renovation project which began in October and is not expected to be completed until at least March of 2020. However, pedestrians still have access through the small side gate on Pier, as well as the established access gate on 11th Place, on the south side of City Hall. The security gates and construction impediments have resulted in a 30% drop in revenue on monthly Saturday sale dates. Fortunately, revenue from the Friday open hours, added this year, are compensating for the loss. Many thanks to the FOL volunteers who have made these additional hours possible. We are currently open 9 a.m. to noon Monday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday, and the third Saturday of every month. Access by car through the Eleventh Place gate for large donations and pickups during our open hours is still available. Delivering book donations directly to Bard Street has two big advantages: (1) one or more volunteers can help you unload, and (2) you can avoid hauling boxes of books up the stairs from the City Hall parking lot to the library's back entrance. However, you can leave book donations at the library when the bookstore is closed, and you can contact us for special help if needed.

60TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

The HBFOL held its 60th birthday party on Saturday, September 15, our regular monthly sale day, in front of the Bard Street Book Store. The weather was still summery, and FOL volunteers Dorothy Yost and Marilyn Shaw served refreshments under an outside canopy to new and returning patrons and quests. Over the past 60 years our organization has provided funds for books, computers, children's reading program entertainment and craft supplies, refreshments for special library events, holiday decorations, magazine and newspaper subscriptions, and occasionally for office equipment and supplies. We look forward to another 60 years of support for the Hermosa Beach Library, one of our most important community assets.

BOOKSTORE GREEN INTO LIBRARY GOLD

The HBFOL has allocated \$1,778 to supplement periodical subscriptions for 2020 and \$2,500 for books and audiovisual materials. Librarian Sarah Harper has used these funds to refresh the Classics collection, primarily Shakespeare plays, and to buy children's favorites like the Harry Potter books in their new illustrated iteration. She has also bought new copies of several popular children's beginner reading series and graphic novels. During the summer she used FOL funds to sponsor prize packs for all ages and to pay for performers at the weekly Summer Discovery programs. Finally, the FOL will award winners of the 2019 Children's Bookmark Contest winners with Barnes and Noble gift certificates, to be presented at the January 2020 City Council meeting. This year's local winners in each grade category:

Once the County grants permission, their artwork will be used on our bookmarks to promote the Bard Street Bookstore Saturday book sales in 2020.
